Superb defensive technique is a hallmark of all great chess-players. While some of the key defensive skills follow well-established principles, modern players ally this with an appreciation of chess dynamics that is a good deal more subtle. Zenon Franco provides a wide-ranging course in how to handle difficult positions, seeking not only to hold them together but to go on the counter-offensive, exploiting to the full the commitments and concessions the opponent has made to launch his attack. The methods he advocates are varied: often a counter-sacrifice is the key, while simplification can also employed as a subtler, but equally deadly weapon.
